

Parade Rules Adopted April 2017 (Revised December 2025)

St. Patrick's Day Parade Committee will consist of the President, Standing Committee Chairman, Parade Chairman, and two other members appointed by the President after consultation with both the Standing Committee Chairman and the Parade Chairman.

Mission Statement

What is the purpose of the parade? The parade, sponsored by the Ancient Order of Hibernians Michael P. Keeley Division 1, St. Clair County Illinois is held to honor Saint Patrick as the Apostle of Ireland, celebrate Irish culture, heritage, and faith, and highlight the contributions the Irish and Irish Americans have made to the United States.

1.) The parade is a non-political parade. It has been so designated, as such by the parade committee and members of the Ancient Order of Hibernians Michael P. Keeley Division 1, St. Clair County, Illinois. No Political signage is allowed. No Political campaigning is allowed. No signage showing election for, or re-election to a political office will be allowed on any floats, vehicles, or carried in the parade, or allowed in or on the parade/staging area or lot. ELECTED OFFICIALS may show the Office the hold, nothing else is allowed. Parade Marshals/Officials can restrict all signage that does not conform to the purpose of the parade they can ask that you remove nonconforming signage. Failure to follow their request results in you and your unit removal from the parade.

2.) Remember decorations or music on your parade float must be consistent with the St. Patrick's Day celebration. You can be asked to alter or remove any material/signage that is found inconsistent - that does not follow the St. Patrick Day scenario or that does not conform to the purpose of the parade. Failure to follow their request results in your removal from the parade.

3.) The police and security officials and parade marshals are there for YOUR protection. Your cooperation is expected if they ask you to do something. Failure to follow their request results in you and your unit's removal from the parade.

4.) Please follow instructions from the Parade Marshals. They are present for your protection and are empowered to remove any non-compliant individuals, groups, or floats from our Parade. Entrants must observe all applicable rules and regulations and follow instructions from police security and parade officials/Marshalls or be barred from the parade. You, and your Float are on display before thousands of you fellow citizens, parents, and children. Please behave accordingly. The Ancient Order of Hibernians Parade Committee reserves the right to remove any entrant from the parade either prior to assembly, while assembling or any time during the parade. Upon arrival at the parade staging area, provide information request by Parade Marshals, that information is necessary to ensure that you are placed on the Parade lot in your assigned position. Please follow all instructions issued by the Parade Marshals, they are there to help you. The Parade Committee's decisions about all entries are final.

5.) All entries/applications received, and approval will be assigned a line-up number. You will be instructed the morning of the parade where to position yourself on the parade staging area/lot, from the Parade Chairman or in his stead a Parade Marshall.

6.) **All entries must be decorated in a St. Patrick's Day theme.** All banners/signage must be neatly lettered and legible. Banners/signage that do not meet the Parades rules must be removed before your entry will be allowed to take part in the Parade. Parade Marshals/Officials can restrict all signage that does not conform to the purpose of the parade. The Parade Marshals/Officials can ask that you remove such signage. Failure to follow their request results in you and your unit being removal from the parade.

7.) The Ancient Order of Hibernians Michael P. Keeley Division 1, Parade Committee will secure St. Patrick for the parade. ** **NO OTHER ST. PATRICK'S CAN TAKE PART.** ** If found in such regalia. Will be asked to remove such. Refusal. Will automatically. Bar you from continuing with the parade. And you will not be allowed to Participate. In the future.

8.) Each vehicle must provide "Wheel Guards." ((2) individuals per van, and or auto, (4) individuals per truck and trailer.) (Wheel guards are to be supplied for each side of the motorized vehicle; wheel guards are to be positioned at each wheel.)

A.) Designated Safety Representative for each unit who will be an active participant in the parade. This person will be the point of contact for any (Emergency Group Call via cell phone). Announcements that will be utilized to notify participants of any major safety concerns. Name & Cell Phone Number of Safety Representative Must be provided on submitted application.

B.) Maximum vehicle width is 8 feet 6 inches.

C.) Maximum length of entered vehicle cannot exceed 60 feet to include length of trailer. - Measured from Front bumper of pulling vehicle to Rear bumper of trailer.

D.) Maximum vehicle height cannot exceed 13 feet 6 inches. Measured from Ground to top of Display.

9.) Please be aware of any overhead obstructions along the parade route when constructing floats. Nothing on Vehicle to include Floats should be Higher than 13 feet 6 inches. Consider passenger safety when constructing your floats.

10.) All units are to keep the pace set by the lead unit and keep no more than 30 feet between units. If a Parade Marshal or the Police or Security or Fire Department personnel instructs you to speed up or slow down, please do so! All units must keep their designated location within the parade, do not swap out or overtake units. (Unless directed to do so by the Parade Marshals, Police, Security or Fire Department personnel.)

11.) Throwing candy, beads, and such items all must be tossed underhanded or handed out by those individuals walking along the curb. (No overhand throwing is allowed) if such occurs and is reported to Parade Official, Marshalls, and or Police, and they contact you, you will have to stop throwing what ever it is and that action may result in you and your unit being barred from future parade participation.

12.) **No** Super Bounce Ball, Silly String, Fireworks, Water-Guns, or anything that might be considered mischievous (Cabbage, Potatoes, Carrots) or hazardous will not be allowed so to avoid personal injury.

13.) Each float operator manages the safety of their participants, their workers, passengers & riders on their float, and or walking in support thereof and must have a complete list of those individuals and contact information for each in case of an emergency. The Ancient Order of Hibernians (AOH) Michael P. Keeley Division 1 St. Clair County its Officers or Members are Not responsible or Liable for the Participant vehicles / float, their workers, riders, and or walkers. It is further understood that the undersigned shall hold harmless the Ancient Order of Hibernians Michael P. Keeley Division 1 St. Clair County Illinois, its Officer, and its Members, the State Office of Illinois Ancient Order of Hibernians, its Officer, and its Members the National Office Ancient Order of Hibernians its Officer, and its Members and the City of Belleville, Illinois from any liability whatsoever which may occur to the undersigned or their participants, workers, riders, and or walkers, during the parade or while in or about the staging area and or lot and authorizes the (AOH) to supply the undersigned participant's contact information to City of Belleville Illinois emergency services. (Fire and Police Departments).

14.) Oak Street Where the Parade Ends, all music must be TURNED OFF.

15.) Respecting the neighborhood means not littering or doing any other action or activities that you would not want to happen to your home or in your neighborhood. Remember you are on display before thousands of your fellow citizens, parents, and children. Please behave accordingly.

16.) Clean up your parade staging/lot area if you leave trash behind you may face a fee of \$100.00 for cleanup and or barred from future parade participation. *** Please clean your designated area. ***

17.) A copy of the rules, signed by the person in charge of the Parade / Float entry, must be in their possession at the start of the parade.

18.) Entries that must be given special consideration –

Bicycles, Battery driven modes of transportation and Horses & or Horse drawn Carriages

Consult with a member of the Ancient Order of Hibernians Parade Committee.

- A.)** Horses must wear bags on lot and street before and during the parade.
- B.)** The rider/driver must always be in control of the horse(s).
- C.) Someone must be appointed to follow all horses or horse drawn carriage to perform cleanup of any spillage that might occur.
- D.)** A copy of the rules, signed by the person in charge of the horse or horse drawn carriage entry, must be in their possession at the start of the parade.

19.) Vehicles: Maximum number of vehicles allowed per entry is (2), Units per Entry **2** are defined as:

(**1** Car or Truck towing a Trailer / Float) or (**2** cars or **2** trucks - No Trailers in tow)
